All modules are worth **20 credits** and start in semester one and conclude in semester two. You will have some discretion over when to complete the practical component of the modules which involves **70 hours of placement visits/work-related learning**.

You will need to **check with your academic school office to see which of the different routes indicated below are available** for your particular degree programme.

- Student Tutoring – helping learners in schools, colleges or community-based organisations
- Student Volunteering – volunteering through the University Student Union Society or SCAN
- Learning from Work – for those who wish to develop their skills using existing part-time term-time work on or off campus

Students who complete a Career Development module in their second year may be able to progress to an **Advanced Career Development** module in their final year. This will involve undertaking a self-initiated project and/or assuming responsibility for others as appropriate for their particular work placement.
