LAB USERS

- Clean the plastic of any hazardous substances,
- Cross out or remove any hazardous waste labels,
- Place in the provided container and inform the Lab Technicians when it is full.

please dispose as clinical waste.

Please do NOT recycle sharp plastic! e.g. Pipette nibs

LAB PLASTIC RECYCLING

LAB TECHNICIANS

- Remove liner containing plastic waste once container is full,
- Sign off the waste; fill out the “CLEAN NON HAZARDOUS LAB PLASTIC FOR RECYCLING” label and securely attach to the bag,
- Transport lab plastic in liner to designated waste collection point in the lift areas by 9.00am each day.
