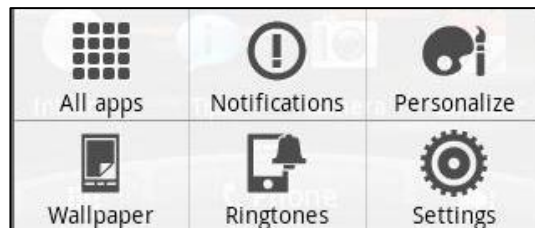


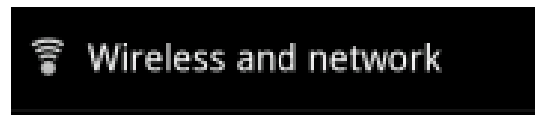
Connecting Android Phone to the University Wireless Service

Select **Settings**

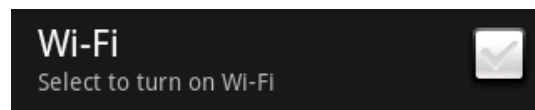
Select **Wireless & networks**

Select **Wi-Fi** to turn on wireless

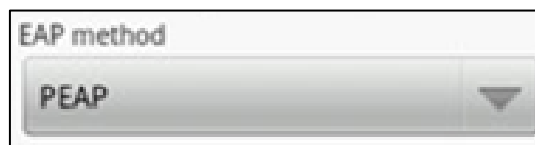


From the list of *Wi-Fi networks* Select **Newcastle-University**



In the *Connect to newcastle-university* window

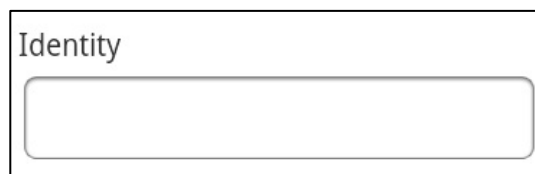
Select *EAP method* and select **PEAP**



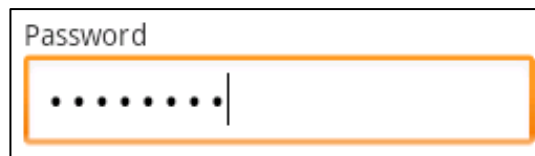
Select *Phase 2 authentication* and select **MSCHAPV2**

i.e. b1234567

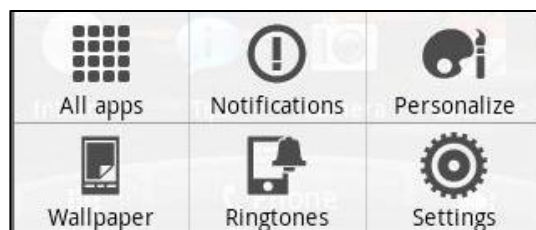
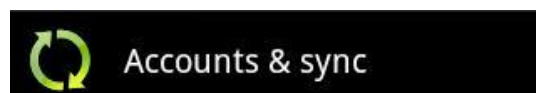
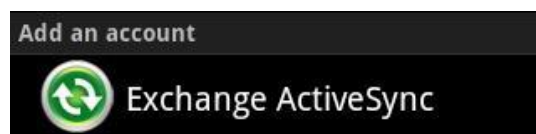


Set *Wireless password* to your University password

Choose what aspects of your Exchange mailbox that you would like selected (**Mail, Contacts, Calendar**) and choose the frequency that the sync will take place then press **Next**.

Give the account a name to distinguish what it is. Exchange ActiveSync is the default name and select **Finish Setup**.

Problems
