

Winsock Fix

WinSock Fix will offer a last resort if your Internet connection is corrupted due to removed or invalid registry entries.

The Winsock Fix Utility will:

- Release the IP address, taking you "Offline"
- Reset the TCP stack using Netsh.exe
- Delete the current Registry TCP and Winsock Values
- Import new "Working" Registry Values

Windows 2000/XP Instructions

Run "winsockxpfix.exe"

Click "Fix"



Click "Yes"



Click "OK" (this will reboot the PC)



Windows Vista Instructions

Right click on "Reset Winsock and TCPIP.bat" and select "Run as administrator"

Press 1 to reboot the PC when prompted.
