

Connect to Wireless with Blackberry

From the *Application Browser*,

- Select the **Manage Connections** icon
- Select the **Wi-Fi** checkbox to turn wireless **On**
- Select **Set Up Wi-Fi Network**
- On the *Set Up Wi-Fi* screen,
- Click **Next**
- Click **Scan For Networks** and wait while it scans
- On the *Available Wi-Fi Networks* screen,
- Click **newcastle-university**
- On the *Wi-Fi Security* screen,
- Set *Security Type* to **PEAP**
- Set *User name* to your University login name i.e. b0123456
- Set *User password* to your University password
- Click *CA certificate* and select either **Comodo AddTrust External CA Root** or **AddTrust External CA Root** (only one should show)
- Set *Inner link security* to **EAP-MS-CHAP v2**
- Click **Connect**
- When connected you are asked,
- Set *Save this W-Fi Network as a Profile?* to **Yes**
- Choose a *Profile Name*
- Click **Next**
- Click **Finish**

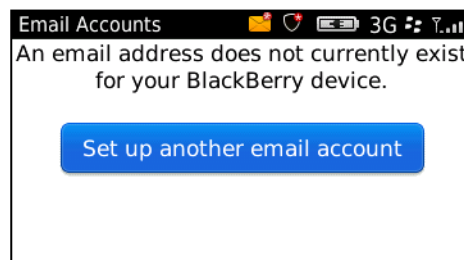
You can now use the applications to access the Internet.

University Email Setup with Blackberry

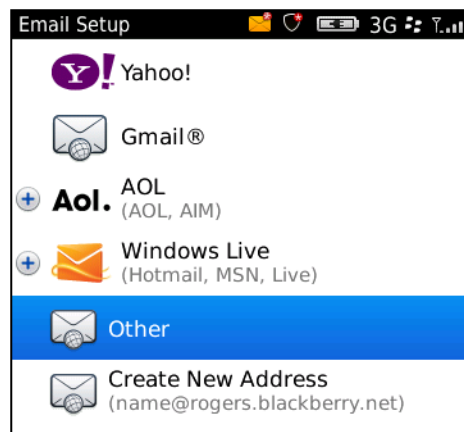
To integrate a Microsoft Outlook Web Access email address using the Email Setup application from the BlackBerry® smartphone, complete the following steps:

Open **Email Settings** on the BlackBerry smartphone.

Click **Set up another email account**.



Choose **Other** from the list of options



Enter the your Newcastle Email address (@newcastle.ac.uk) and Password, then click Continue

The BlackBerry Internet Service will indicate that there was a problem, select I will provide the settings.

Select Outlook Web Access (Exchange)

Enter the following details:-

Outlook Web Access URL:-

User name - campus\”username”
 Replace “username” with your username i.e. campus\b1234567

(If problems try just username i.e. b1234567)

Mailbox name - University

Then click Continue.

Select what you would like to sync and then the email account should then be successfully added.
