Macintosh OS Leopard v10.5+ Step by Step Instructions

Plug Network Cable into Mac.

Open **System Preferences** by going to the **Apple** menu and choosing "System Preferences..."

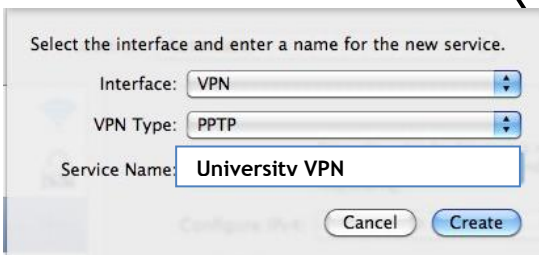
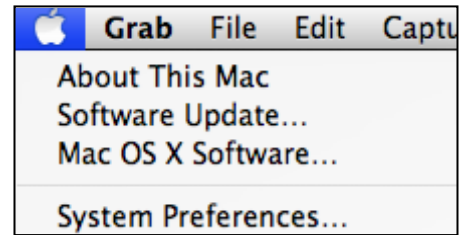
Click on the 'Network' system preference.



Select the **Plus (+)** button



Choose **VPN** as the Interface
Choose **PPTP** as the VPN Type
In Service Name type **University VPN**
Click **Create**



Enter the following:

Server Address: **ivpn.ncl.ac.uk**

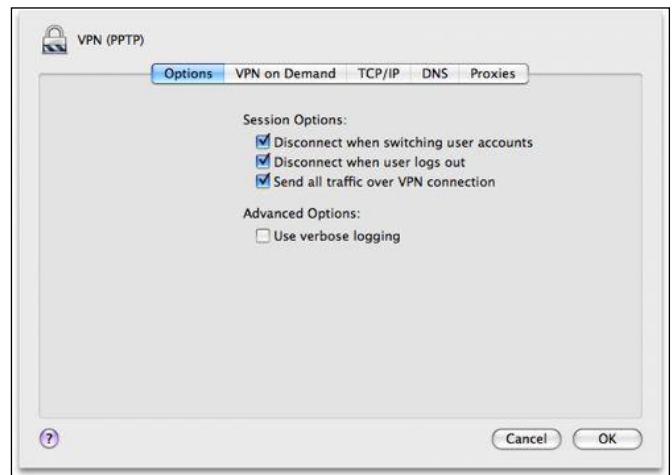
Account Name: **Your Windows login ID**

Click "Authentication Settings" and enter your "Windows login Password"

Tick **Show VPN status in menu bar**

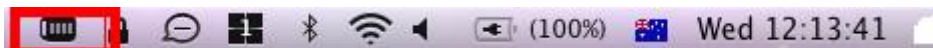
Click "Advanced..."

Tick "Send all traffic over VPN connection"



Connecting to the VPN

Click on the **VPN Icon** on the main menu bar and select **University VPN**



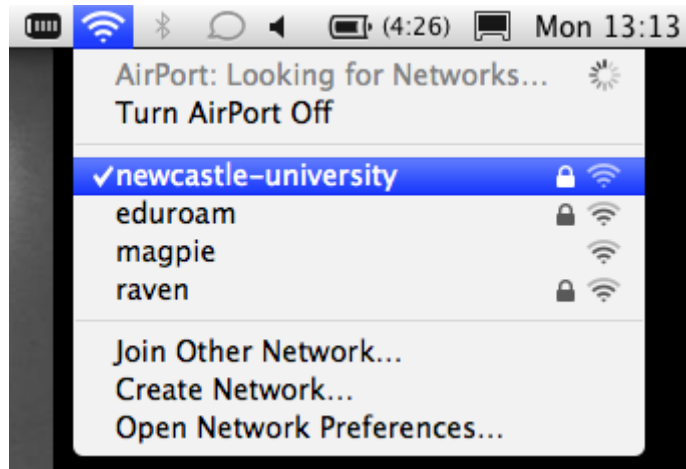
Problems

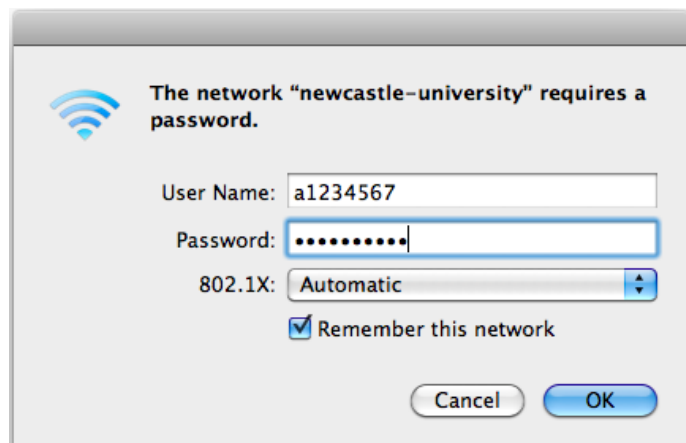
Click the AirPort menu
