


Windows XP - Wireless Setup

Double Click  on the task bar (*Bottom right corner of the screen*)

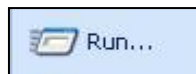
Click “ncl-uni-wifi-setup” from the list of Networks and click “Connect”



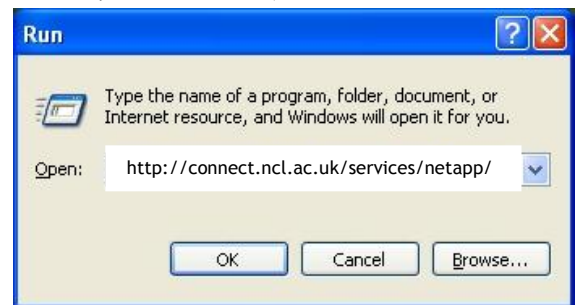
You are now connected to the Setup Wireless which lets you download the program to install the correct certificates for Newcastle-University Wireless. (You cannot use Setup wireless for normal web browsing)


Click the “Start Button”  (*Bottom left corner of the screen*)

Click on “Run”



Enter the following address then click “OK”

You will now be connected to the Connect page with a link to the Campus Network Setup program; click the  button and save the file.

Locate the Campus Network Setup program and double click on it

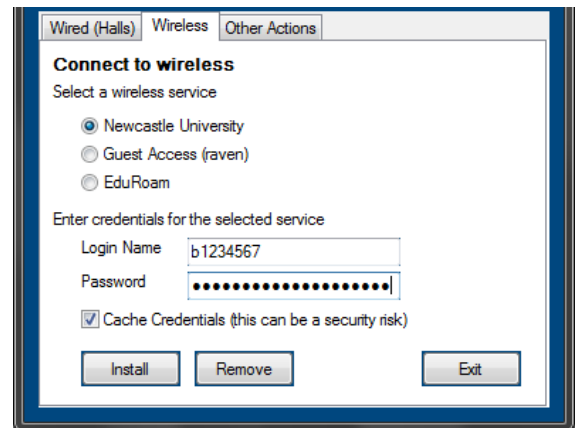


Click “Wireless” Tab



Select “Newcastle University”

Enter your University Login name and Password

Click “Install”



Connect to “Newcastle-University” wireless access point

Double Click  or  on the task bar (*Bottom right corner of the screen*)

Click “Newcastle-University” from the list of Networks.



Click “Connect”

(Connect to this network every time you want to use Wireless at Newcastle University)

Windows XP - Docking Setup (Halls of Residence with a Network Cable)

Connect the “Network Cable” to your PC

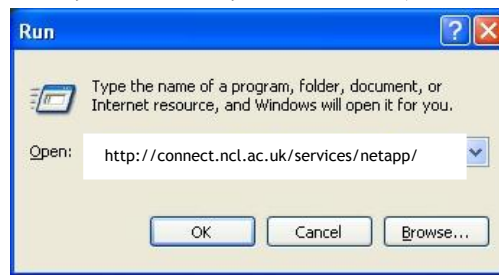
Click the “Start Button”  (Bottom left corner of the screen)


Click on “Run”



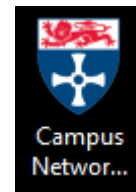
Enter the following address then click “OK”

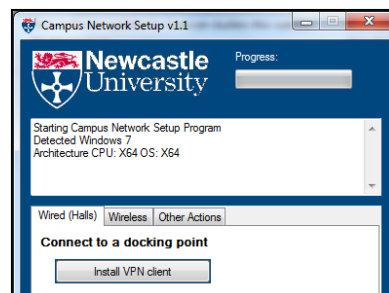


You will now be connected to the Connect page with a link to the Campus Network Setup program; click the  button and save the file.

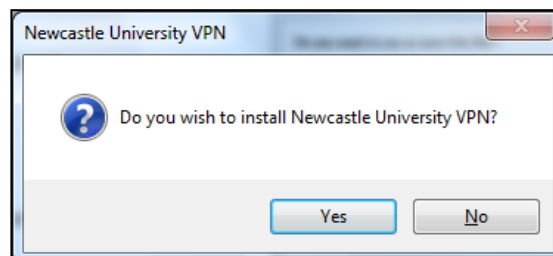
Locate the **Campus Network Setup** program and **double click** on it



Click “Install VPN client”

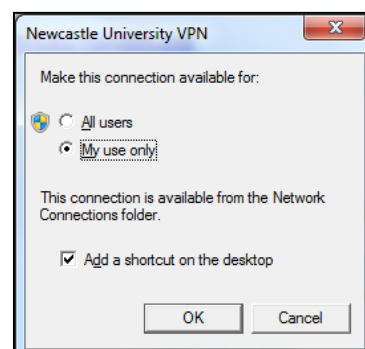


Click “Yes”



Select “My use only” and tick the box next to “Add a shortcut on the desktop”

Click “OK”



You will now have a Shortcut on the desktop; each time you want to connect to the internet using Docking you need to double click the icon and enter your University Login name and Password then click connect.
