Introduction

This collection of brass rubbings was made by Oswin J. Charlton M.A., LL.M., F.S.A. (1871-1941). Solicitor and Antiquary of Newcastle upon Tyne, mainly during his student days in Cambridge.

On Mr. Charlton's death his large collection of books on the subject of monumental brasses was purchased by the Library, but the rubbings themselves were presented by his brother, G.V. Charlton, Esq. An obituary notice of O.J. Charlton appeared in *Archaeologia Aeliana*, Ser. 4, Vol. 20, 1942 pp. 8-10.

This index is now offered to those interested in the subject to make the collection more widely known than it has been: its compilation has afforded a few hours of welcome respite from the usual library administration.
