- **Canadian Society of Civil Engineers (CSCE)**. Canada, national.
- **Cleveland Institution of Engineers (CIE)**. UK regional based in Middlesbrough, Cleveland serving the Teesside, North East / North Yorkshire Coast.
- **Collegio degli Ingegneri Navali e Meccanic in Italia (CINM)**. Italy, national.
- **Engineers Association of New South Wales (EANSW)**. Australia, regional.
- **Hull and District Institution of Engineers and Naval Architects (HDIENA)**. UK regional based in Hull, Yorkshire serving Hull and the Yorkshire Coast.
- **Institute of Marine Engineers / Institute of Marine Engineers, Scientists and Technologists (IMarE / IMarEST)**. UK national based in London serving the whole UK.
- **Institution of Engineers and Shipbuilders in Scotland (IESS/IESIS)**. UK regional based in Glasgow serving Scotland especially the Clyde and Firth of Forth.
- **Liverpool Engineering Society (LES)**. UK regional based in Liverpool serving Merseyside and the North West Coast.
- **North East Coast Institution of Engineers and Shipbuilders (NECIES)**. UK regional based in Newcastle upon Tyne serving Tyneside, Wearside, and North East England.
- **Royal Institution of Naval Architects / Institution of Naval Architects (RINA/ INA)**. UK national based London serving the whole UK.
- **Societe Scientifique et Industrielle de Marseilles (SSIM)**. France, regional.
- **United States Naval Institute (USNI)**. USA, national.
- **Vereines Deutscher Ingenieure (VDI)**. Germany, national.
