Proceedings of the United States Naval Institute, vl[v1]=ca.1874 – to date. A US-based professional navy engineering learned society, mainly for deck officers, devoted to naval power and maritime heritage publishing a technical research journal. Zeitschrift des Vereines Deutscher Ingenieure, (ZVDI), [in German = German Engineers Association Magazine], v1=1858 – to date, Julius Springer, Berlin, Germany. Later various similar titles, ISBN 0341-7255 then 0372-543-X, Springer V D I Verlag GmbH & Co. KG. A German-based very high quality technical research journal. Covers the whole spectrum of engineering activities primarily in Germany – one of the leading nations in new technical developments – and internationally. Includes occasional articles about shipbuilding, shiprepairing, marine-engine building, & related activities.

Foerster, publisher Verlag von Julius Springer, Berlin, Germany. A German-based trade and industry technical magazine. Launched in the revival of Germany just after the devastation of the WWI. Contains articles and papers ranging from short editorial news items to substantial reviews. German and international coverage. Superb photographs, fold-out illustrations including ship general arrangements. Includes **Das Motorschiff** organ dur die Technik der Motorschifffahrt und die zugehörigen Industrien. Refs: none.
