**Scholarships ranging from a minimum of £2,500 each, to full tuition fee waiver are available. If awarded, international scholarships are deducted from the tuition fees.** Tuition fees for 2012 entry are **£11,165**

### Eligibility

**The scholarships are awarded exclusively on academic merit in recognition of academic excellence.** This includes:

- Recent Graduates
- Undergraduates completing their course before September 2012
- Those currently completing professional legal qualifications
- Non-Law Graduates in a discipline related to the programme
- Applicants classified as International students

### Requirements

- A 2:1 (Honours) degree or equivalent obtained before September 2012
- If English is not your first language and if you have not undertaken any programme of study in which English is the medium of instruction you will be required to show adequate language proficiency for postgraduate study in Law. Our requirement is **IELTS 6.5 with at least 6.5 in writing.**
