

## **Programme Regulations 2009/10**

### **Institution of Electrical Engineers Continuing Education Modular Master's Scheme**

#### **See also:**

The University has adopted the 'Regulations for MSc Option' of the Continuing Education Modular Master's (CEMM) scheme, administered by the Institution of Electrical Engineers. (Copies of the Regulations may be obtained from: IEE, Station House, Nightingale Road, Hitchin, Herts SG5 1JR.) Students may accordingly be registered for the MSc under this scheme. The following rules, additional to the published regulations, also apply:

- (a) students who register for the MSc must study and pass at examination a programme module that is offered by this University under the scheme, in addition to undertaking an individual project supervised by staff of the University;
- (b) the minimum total permitted period of study of the MSc is two years and the maximum permitted period is five years;
- (c) two programme modules, out of the required total of four, must be studied and passed at examination, before work on the project may begin.
