**Module:** In this example **MEC2001** is a module from the School of Mechanical Engineering. **BIO** would be Biology, **GEO** Geography etc. The **module title** is viewable in the list format, or when you **hover the mouse pointer over the cell** in grid format.

**Class Type:** After the module code there is further important information (**MEC2001/L02/01**)

**L01** This letter represents the type of class e.g. MEC/L02/01 here **L** is a **Lecture**, other codes you may see are **S**eminar, **C**omputer class, **T**utorial, **P**ractical. In this example, the number following the letter indicates that this is lecture two of the module, it may have further lectures, seminars or practical classes, e.g. practical one MEC2001/P01/01 or the third seminar in the series MEC2001/S03/01. You will be expected to attend all of these classes.

**L02/01** The final number in the activity MEC2001/L01/01 indicates if a class is repeated a number of times to different groups of students e.g. MEC1003/S01/01, MEC1003/S01/02, MEC1003/S01/03 are the first, second and third repeats of seminar one for MEC1003. You will only be expected to attend one of the numbered sessions, your School or module leader will tell you which.

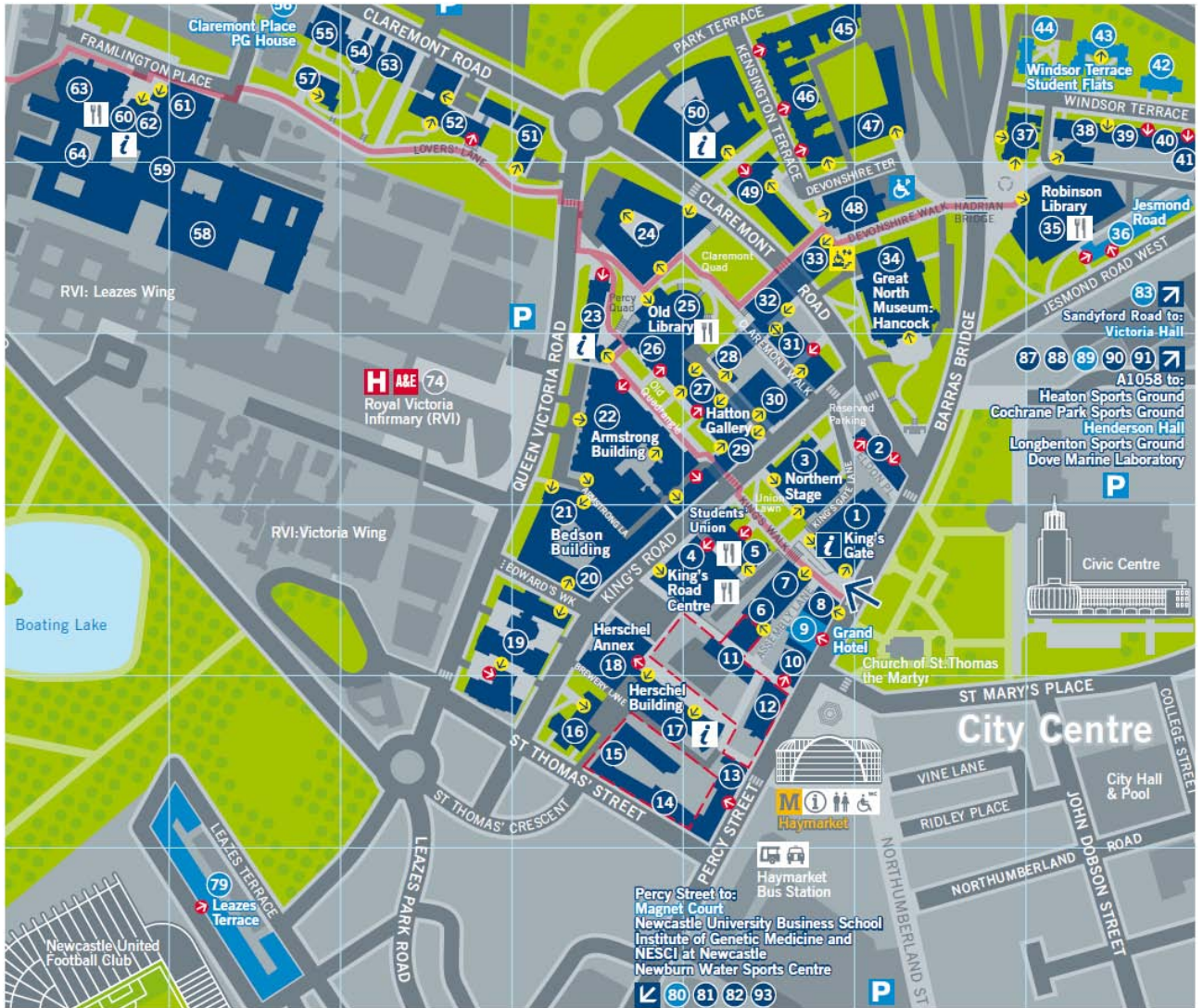
**Week Numbers:** These numbers indicate the timetable weeks or week ranges a class will take place (a **simple guide showing the timetable week and date week beginning is a shown at the top of your timetable**). In this example the seminar will run in weeks 29-35, 40-44 which is semester 2.

**Location Code:** The location is indicated by an abbreviation, in this example **STB.F16 (1.13)** is lecture theatre **F16 (1.13)** in the **Stephenson Building**. **More information on the classroom is displayed if you hover the mouse pointer over the location name**. A full list of Buildings and abbreviations of their names is provided in this guide.
