

2017 PTES Prize Draw Terms & Conditions

Promoter:

Newcastle University is running a free prize draw for students who take part in the Postgraduate Taught Experience Survey (PTES). The Learning and Teaching Development Service (LTDS), contactable by email lt ds@ncl.ac.uk, will administer the prize draw.

Eligibility:

The prize draw is open to all postgraduate students who have received an invitation to take part in the PTES and have submitted a completed survey.

The eligible PTES population includes all full-time and most part-time UK, EU, and international PGT students studying a programme of at least 60 credits, the greater part of which is at M level at all campuses (i.e., Newcastle, Newcastle University Medicine Malaysia, Newcastle University International Singapore, and Newcastle University London), including eLearning students. The University excludes all first year part-time students from the PTES, except when they are on a PGT programme that is one year part-time only (e.g., PG Certificates). It also excludes students who are studying a single module only; e.g., CPD and occasional students. The PTES population should include study abroad and exchange students.

Promotion period:

Entries will be accepted from Monday 17 April until Friday 16 June 2017

Entry:

Entry into the prize draw is activated on receipt of a completed PTES questionnaire. No purchase or payment is required.

Limitation of entries:

Only one entry per eligible student will be accepted.

Prizes:

1st Place prize: 9.7-inch iPad Pro (one available to win)

2nd Place prizes: iPad mini 4 (two available to win)

3rd Place prizes: £20 Amazon gift card (20 available to win)

No transfer or assignment of prizes will be permitted except by Newcastle University. Newcastle University reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. No cash alternative can be substituted for any prize.

Draw:

The winners will be drawn at random from all eligible entries; an observer independent of LTDS will witness the draw. The draw will be conducted within one week of the survey closing. All prize draw decisions are final and binding.

Notification:

Winners will be notified within two weeks of the date of the draw. Notification will be sent to the student's University email address or by telephone, as appropriate and required. Should the winner fail to collect, or arrange to collect, the prize within six weeks of receiving notification that they are the winner, they will forfeit their right to the prize and a further draw will be conducted on the same basis as described above.

Use of your personal information for this prize draw:

Newcastle University will use any contact details they hold to contact the winners. The University will not pass winner's personal information to any third party.

Liability

Newcastle University is not responsible for late, lost, misdirected, mechanically reproduced, mis-delivered, incomplete, illegible, or unintelligible entries, messages or post; unavailable network connections; failed, incomplete, garbled, or delayed computer transmission; online failures; hardware/software or other technical malfunctions or disturbances; or any other communications failures or circumstances affecting, disrupting or corrupting the prize draw in any manner. The University is not responsible for any inaccuracy in the contact details supplied by the student that may result in the inability of the University to contact the student. The University also is not responsible for any damage to the entrant's computer resulting from participation in the survey, or from downloading of any information necessary to participate in the survey.

Jurisdiction:
