Annotated editions of children's 'classics' often contain much invaluable scholarship which is not accessible through normal critical booklists and check-lists. This check-list brings together over 100 examples; the detail of the annotation varies widely between (and sometimes within) series, but most of the books listed have an Introduction and Notes - and at the least a substantial Introduction. (I have not seen all of these books, and I would appreciate information on any that do not!)

As always with Children's Literature there are boundary disputes. I have included the Vintage 'Whole Story' series, despite the fact that it is aimed at a young audience; similarly, I have excluded some books that appear in 'children's literature' annotated series, such as *Frankenstein*, but have included others that might be regarded as adult texts, notably *Kim* and *The Prisoner of Zenda*.

As this is the first attempt at this list, any additions, subtractions or comments would be happily received.
