Stage 3 Joint Honours Pre-registration Information for 2018/19

Economics and Mathematics, Accounting and Mathematics

In respect of MAS modules students are expected to pre-register for sets of modules. Choose one from the Semester 1 sets and pre-register for the modules in this set. Choose one from the Semester 2 sets and pre-register for the modules in this set. Except for NCL3007 as described for each programme below, departure from these sets is only permitted with special permission of the Degree Programme Director and this can only be granted on the basis of unusual circumstances (it will not be granted on the basis of a personal preference for some modules over others). However changes to module selections may be made in September if the timetable allows, at which time any selection that meets the requirements of the degree programme regulations may be made. Please note:

- You are required to pre-register for 60 credits in each semester.
- It is important to pay attention to pre-requisites and especially to co-requisites. Note that 'co-requisites' can include Semester 1 modules required in order to study Semester 2 modules.

NG41 (Accounting and Mathematics)

This programme has compulsory modules ACC3001 and ACC3002 (each 20 credits). In addition students must select either ACC3000 or ACC3006 (but see below). In respect of MAS modules, MAS3091 is compulsory in Semester 1, but otherwise the selection depends on the student's pathway:

- **Applied Mathematics:** if you are taking MAS2802 and MAS2803 in Stage 2.
- **Statistics:** if you are taking MAS2902 and MAS2903 in Stage 2.

Students on the **Applied Mathematics** pathway must select from sets 121 – 123 in Semester 1 and from 131 – 134 in Semester 2.

Students on the **Statistics pathway** must select from sets 124 – 126 in Semester 1 and from 135 – 138 in Semester 2.

Please note:

- You may not pre-register for modules that lie outside both the School of Mathematics & Statistics and Accounting, except that you may replace ACC3000/ACC3006 by NCL3007.

GL11 (Economics and Mathematics)

This programme has one compulsory Economics module: ECO3001 (20 credits). Students must select 40 additional credits of ECO modules (selecting from ECO3002, ECO3004, ECO3010, ECO3018, ECO3037). The total ECO module split must be 30 credits in each semester. In respect of MAS modules, MAS3091 is compulsory in Semester 1, but the selection of additional MAS module depends on the student's pathway:

- **Applied Mathematics:** if you are taking MAS2802 and MAS2803 in Stage 2.
- **Statistics:** if you are taking MAS2902 and MAS2903 in Stage 2.

Students on the **Applied Mathematics** pathway:

- Students must select from sets 121 – 123 in Semester 1 and from 131 – 134 in Semester 2.

Students on the **Statistics** pathway:

- Students must select from sets 124 – 126 in Semester 1 and from 135 – 138 in Semester 2.

Please note:

- You may not pre-register for modules that lie outside both the School of Mathematics & Statistics and Economics, except that you may replace one 20 credit ECO module or two 10 credit ECO modules by NCL3007. In practice this means that you must then register for NCL3007 and ECO3001, and then for a further 20 credits of ECO modules. For the purposes of selecting MAS modules you should regard NCL3007 as an ECO module.
