Transfer to Medicine or Dentistry

Home and international students on some of the School of Biomedical, Nutritional and Sport Sciences degree programmes are eligible to apply to transfer to Medicine or Dentistry after their first year of study (excludes Sport and Exercise Science and Human Nutrition and Food programmes).

- Students will be selected on the basis of academic performance in the first year, their UCAT score, a personal statement and, if shortlisted, an interview.
- Transfer is into first year of the Medicine or Dentistry course. A lecture timetabled in the December of your first year of study gives you further information regarding the transfer schemes.

In 2018-19, 49 students applied to transfer to Medicine. 14 were interviewed of which 7 received conditional offers subject to semester 2 results.	In 2018-19, 9 students applied to transfer to Dentistry. 2 were interviewed of which 1 received a conditional offer subject to semester 2 results.

Important: You will need to provide evidence of a personal UCAT score achieved within 2 years of commencing your Bioscience programme on application to the transfer scheme. Details on how to register and sit the UCAT can be found at www.ucat.ac.uk. It is your individual responsibility to have a UCAT score ready at the time of transfer application.
