<p>Student workers who need to self-isolate</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inform your role supervisor • Inform the university • Go home or stay at home • Self-isolate in line with NHS Guidance on self-isolation
<p>Student workers who test positive for Covid-19</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inform your role supervisor of the positive test result • Inform the university of the positive test result • Go home or stay at home • Self-isolate in line with NHS Guidance on self-isolation
<p>Student workers who test negative for Covid-19</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Notify your line manager or supervisor about your negative results • You do not need to self-isolate if your test is negative, as long as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ everyone you live with who has symptoms tests negative ○ you were not told to self-isolate for by NHS Test and Trace ○ you feel well – if you feel unwell, stay at home until you're feeling better <p>For current rules on self-isolation see the current NHS Guidance on self-isolation</p>

Supervisor: Responsibilities relating to Student Workers and Covid:19

Student worker reports that they are displaying symptoms of Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check that the student has informed the university • Advise the student to book a PCR test for Covid-19 • Advise the student to go home or stay at home and to self-isolate in line with NHS Guidance
Student workers who need to self-isolate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check that the student has informed the university • Advise the student to go home or stay at home and to self-isolate in line with NHS Guidance on self-isolation
Students workers who test positive for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask the student to identify any close contacts from the workplace. • Ask they student if they consent for their results to be shared with affected colleagues • Advise the student to inform the university of the positive test result • Advise the student to go home or stay at home • Advise the student to self-isolate in line with NHS Guidance • Advise any staff and students who you or the student involved have been identified as close contacts to self isolate if required under current NHS Guidance on self-isolation.
Students workers who test negative for Covid-19	<p>The student may return to work as long as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ everyone they live with who has symptoms tests negative ○ they were not told to self-isolate for by NHS Test and Trace ○ they feel well – if they feel unwell, they should stay at home until they are feeling better <p>For current rules on self-isolation see the current NHS Guidance on self-isolation</p>
