



## Turley Planning Bursary In Memory of Stuart Irvine

The School of Architecture, Planning & Landscape, in association with Turley, is pleased to offer **two Stuart Irvine - Turley Planning Bursary** awards for young people from under-represented backgrounds, to study Planning at Newcastle University commencing in September 2023. Students on the scheme will have a **£5,000** maintenance bursary paid for Stages 1 & 2, **increasing to £7,500** in Stage 3 (and Stage 4 if studying K400 Master of Planning). For students on the K400 Master of Planning programme there will be no payment during the Certificate in Planning Practice year, but a placement opportunity may be available with Turley.

### How to Apply

To be eligible for one of the bursaries, students should hold an offer to study either BA Hons Urban Planning (K421) or Master of Planning (K400) at Newcastle following the usual UCAS processes. Additional eligibility criteria is noted on the application form and within the Terms and Conditions.
