Terms and Conditions

All students must meet all the following criteria and terms and conditions in order to be considered for the bursary and receive the award.

Eligibility criteria for scholars and applicants

1. Regarded as a home/UK status student for tuition fees and student finance.
2. Students self-identify as meeting one of the following criteria:
 - a. Carer/ Caring Responsibilities;
 - b. Care Leaver/ Care Experienced;
 - c. Estranged Student;
 - d. Refugee/ Asylum Seeker;
 - e. Gypsy/ Roma Travelling Community;
 - f. Diverse Ethnic Heritage & attended a UK state school throughout schooling;
 - g. Students who are eligible for the NU Opportunity Scholarship or Newcastle University Undergraduate Support Bursary.
3. Has received an offer to study BA Hons Urban Planning (K421) or Master of Planning/MPlan (K400) to commence in September 2023.
4. Scholarship applications must be submitted to Newcastle University by midday on Friday 1 September 2023.
5. Not studied in higher education previously. Only applicants with exceptional circumstances could be considered outside these criteria.
6. By applying for the award, you are confirming that you are happy for your details to be shared with Turley as part of the shortlisting process.

Terms and conditions

- This award is not transferrable.
- The award will only be instigated if you meet the conditions of your programme offer – the offer you have received via UCAS for BA Hon Urban Planning (K421) or MPlan (K400)
- The bursary will be paid in instalments in line with NU's normal Bursary and Scholarship payment schedule.
- Payments are not made during repeat years of study - payments and contributions are made for the first attempt at a Stage only.
- Any bursary payments made by NU/ Student Loans Company (SLC) after a student has interrupted their studies or withdrawn from the University will normally be recovered from the student.
- Any bursary payment made by NU/ SLC in error OR paid as a result of false information submitted will normally be recovered from the student.
- Payments are triggered via NU returning a positive registration and attendance confirmations at the relevant points. This process is carried out automatically on your behalf. Students whose SFE, SFW, SFNI, SAAS record is not in a position to have their attendance confirmed will experience a delay in payment.

Terms and Conditions

- Upon acceptance your details will be shared with Turley, which may include information on your progress during your studies.
- You may be required to engage in and participate with extra-curricular activities organised by the School and Turley which are designed to support students as they progress through their degree.
- You may be required to take part in publicity and promotion around the award by both Newcastle University and Turley – if there are exceptional reasons as to why this would not be appropriate then please liaise with the University.
- You will not be considered for the Turley Planning Bursary under the following circumstances:
 - You already hold a degree at Honours level or equivalent.
 - You are regarded as 'International' for Tuition Fee purposes.
 - You do not identify as meeting one of the additional eligibility criteria as stipulated above and on the application form.
 - You have deferred your studies from 2023/24 to 2024/25.
 - You are studying a programme other than BA Hons Urban Planning (K421) or MPlan (K400)
