Module Choice Guide – Returning Students

Terms used in this guide



Term	Description
Module Selection	Depending on your programme of study, you may be required to select modules. This enables you to focus on specific topics and themes, that will support you to build knowledge and skills for your future career. If your programme enables you to select modules, these are known as 'Optional Modules'. You will be asked to choose modules via the Student Portal at a specific time, known as the 'Module Choice Window' Not all modules can be chosen in the Student Portal, as they maybe modules that are applied automatically, known as 'Compulsory Modules' You may have a combination of Optional and Compulsory Modules, or just Compulsory. Module Choice happens in September, mostly for First Year students, however the main Module Choice event happens in April/May for students choosing modules for their next year of study (Returning UG students).
Choosing Modules	You will work with your school to understand what 'Optional Modules' you can choose in support of your programme regulations. You will use the Student Portal to view and choose your Modules, adding up to 120 or 180 credits (depending on your programme). This will include both Optional and Compulsory Modules. You cannot choose more than the agreed credits, which the Student Portal will prevent you from doing. Once you have the required credits, you will submit your selected Modules, which will 'book' a place on that Module.
Capped Modules	Modules can be capped, which means there will be a limited number of places available on a Module. The Student Portal will highlight any capped Modules to you. Once the cap has been reached you will be notified the Module is 'Full'. The Module only becomes booked when you 'submit' your chosen Modules - therefore it is important you your modules quickly when selecting Capped Modules, or the Module place may be taken and become full.
Pre-requisites	Modules may have prerequisites, which means you must comply with the prerequisite to choose the Module. The Module information will highlight if there is a prerequisite and link you to the Module Catalogue, where you can view further information.
School Approval	Modules may require approval from the School. When you 'submit' your Module Choice, the status will be 'Waiting Approval'. You will be informed by the School if your selection was successful or unsuccessful. This will be managed through the Student Portal.

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Scroll down to view your available 'Optional' Modules, (the list of the modules that you can choose from with the associated credits and semesters). To search for a module, scroll down the list or search using the Code or Title in the 'Search' field.

It will also highlight if the module has any pre-requisites/co-requisites (shown as blue triangle). If you click onto this icon a pop-up box will appear detailing the information.

It will also highlight if the module is a capped module or if it is full.

You can click onto the 'Module Code' also, to review further information about the module, which will take you to the 'Module Catalogue'.

To search for a module, you can;

- Add the Module Code or Title in the 'Search'
 field,
- Scroll down the list of 'All' modules, ensuring the 'Subject' field displays 'All'
- Or, you can search by 'Subject'. Use the 'Subject' drop down, to choose the relevant subject and stage and click 'Apply Filters'. A list of the associated modules for that subject and stage will be displayed for you to choose from.
- You can change the 'Subject' drop down, to review another subject and stage, but ensure to click 'Apply Filter' each time, to update the list of available Modules.

If the Module is 'Capped' (meaning there are limited places on that module), this will be highlighted on the 'Type' field as 'Optional Capped'

You can select this module in the same way as any other Module, but you must be quick to 'Submit'.

Once submitted, the Module will then be held against you. If you don't submit quickly, the Module place may be taken by another student and then the Module will become 'Full'. If this did happen a warning message would appear, and the Module would state 'Full'. You would need to choose another Module.

You will then choose the 'Optional' Modules, by highlighting the relevant modules (tick box).

- Total credits must equal 120 before the modules can be submitted. Anything less and the modules cannot be submitted.
- A semester credit value cannot be less than 50 or more than 70. If less or more, the modules cannot be submitted. The only exception to this is Part Time students where their credits can be less.

Once chosen you will click 'Add Selected'.

You can do this by selecting one at a time (see next slide) or by choosing them all at once..

If you choose one Module at a time and then click 'Add Selected', a message will be highlighted to state, 'Modules added successfully' (this will also appear if all Modules are selected)

The Selected Modules will be added to the 'Selected Modules' table and will be set as 'draft'. The credits will be updated. If all the credits have been chosen for that semester a 'green tick' will appear.

You can also remove any modules you may have chosen incorrectly, by clicking 'Remove'

If further modules still need to be added the 'Credits To Add' will be updated and the 'Add Selected' button will remain
