H. <b>Bocler</b> , ca.1877-1959, naval architect	Notes from his time as a student. Professional notebooks full of calculation methods and designing from his drawings from his time as naval architect to Swan Hunter.
John <b>Scott Russell</b> , 1808-1882, naval architect	His enormous textbook "The modern system of naval architecture", 3 vols, 1860, with amazing line drawings and ship general arrangement plans including the <i>Great Eastern</i> . But no personal materials are held in the Collection.
Prof. E. V. <b>Telfer</b> , 1897-1977, consultant naval architect	Personal and professional materials (kindly donated by his family). His career spanned professional consultancy and academia, using his wide breadth of knowledge.
