Student applications

Detailed guidelines and an information booklet with a link to the student's application will be sent to them once our office has reviewed and accepted their nomination.

All students must submit:

- Motivation letter
- preferred module choices
- transcript of studies
- a valid passport
- a portfolio should this be required (Architecture, Fine Art, Music and Landscape Architecture)

English requirements

If you are nominating a student from an EU university, please can you provide the student with a letter confirming that the level of their English is at least CEFR B2. If you are nominating a student from a non-EU university, they will be required to [provide us with evidence](#) to the level of their English.

Module/course guidance

Newcastle University maintains an [online list of modules](#) available to exchange students. We also include guidance on understanding our academic structure and choosing modules. Exchange students can take 50-70 NCL credits per semester. Modules are finalised when students arrive on campus.
