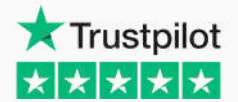
Founded in 2015, Travelteer offers students affordable volunteering and travel adventures that allow them to experience new cultures in a safe and exciting environment.

We have established a long-term strategy to regenerate vital rainforest areas and preserve marine life in Sri Lanka's Southern Province. Through a variety of hands-on projects, volunteers will be fully engaged in environmental conservation efforts, including restoring sea turtle populations, replanting native trees, and combating plastic pollution.

Project 1: Sea Turtle Conservation

Volunteers will have the opportunity assist at our Sea Turtle sanctuary - maintaining the sanctuary, building artificial nesting sites & releasing hatchlings into the wild.

Many rural school children can understand and speak basic words in English, however their comprehension and conversational skills are underdeveloped. This programme gives volunteers hands-on experience in an international education system, providing global perspective and insight into childhood development in different educational settings.

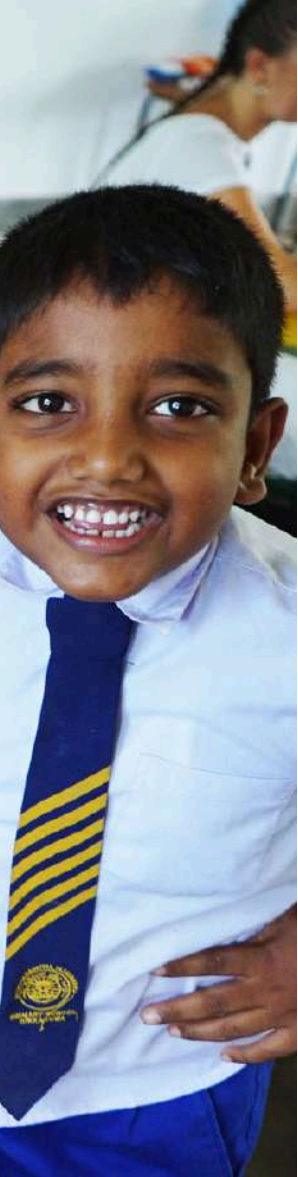

Nepal has some of the most iconic landscapes on earth and is home to the highest mountain range in the world - the Himalayas.

This beautiful country shares borders with China in the north and India in the west, east and south and is home to nearly 30 million people. Sadly, 20% of these citizens are living in poverty which rates Nepal as the 5th poorest country in Asia.

Our Community Development programme aims to provide outreach support to remote mountain communities. Travelteer works in villages throughout the mountainous region surrounding Pokhara, developing education, infrastructure and agriculture.

Project 1: Education & Sports

The focus of our educational element depends on each school's needs. Volunteers will generally assist with teaching interactive English Lessons, as well as coaching sport lessons in local schools. Your fundraising helps provide equipment for schools and handheld solar lights for children living off the electricity grid.

Project 2: Infrastructure

Volunteers will assist in the improvement of school facilities, from the re-vamping of classrooms to the construction of disabled ramps in schools.

Project 3: Agriculture

We partner with each mountain community to help contribute to the village's agriculture. Volunteers will immerse themselves in the community with everyday farming tasks and projects.

Volunteer in Vietnam.

Bordering China, Laos, and Cambodia, and stretching along the South China Sea, Vietnam is home to over 100 million people and a variety of ethnic groups.

Despite its rapid growth, many rural communities still face hardship—particularly in the northern highlands, where access to education and resources is limited. Our volunteering projects focus on wildlife conservation, eco-farming and youth development in these areas – we aim to make a big impact in disadvantaged communities.

Based around Sa Pa and Yen Bai province in the north of the country, these programmes support the protection of endangered wildlife, the implementation of sustainable farming practices and provide opportunities for local children through English education and sports coaching.

The homestay provides a warm, authentic setting—perfect for building connections and gaining a deeper understanding of Vietnam's northern culture.

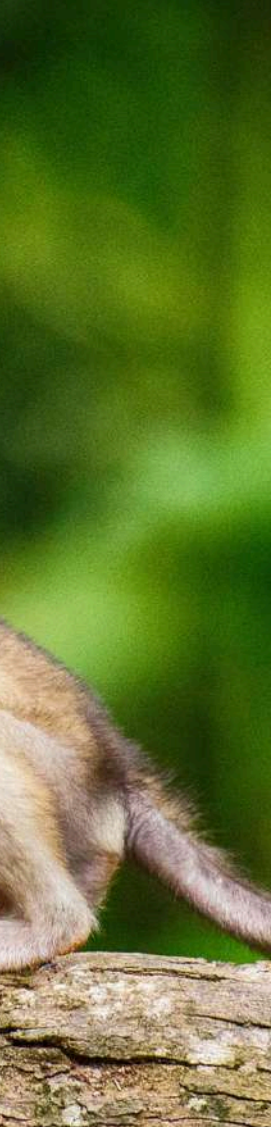

Project 1: Wildlife Rescue Centre

In partnership with the environmental department, this project takes place at an animal rescue centre in Sa Pa, where volunteers support the care and rehabilitation of animals rescued from the illegal wildlife trade. Tasks may include preparing food, cleaning enclosures, assisting with basic care, and helping maintain the surrounding environment. Working closely with local conservation staff, volunteers play a vital role in giving these animals a second chance.

Project 2: Eco-farming

As part of our eco-farming project in Sa Pa, volunteers work alongside local families on traditional farming tasks such as planting, harvesting, composting, and ploughing the land. You'll also help care for livestock like pigs and chickens, which are essential to the community's self-sufficiency. It's a hands-on, rewarding experience that offers a real insight into rural life and sustainable agriculture in northern Vietnam.

At Travelteer, we focus on creating a lasting impact. At the animal rescue centre, we aim to develop improved enclosures that provide safer, more natural environments for rescued wildlife. In the surrounding rural areas, we're working to support local communities with sustainable farming initiatives, helping improve food security and livelihoods.

Education

The Education programme works in partnership with schools in Sa Pa and Yen Bai province, aiming to create sustainable opportunities for young people in rural communities through language learning and physical education.

While many students have a basic understanding of English, their speaking, listening, and confidence in communication are often limited due to a lack of exposure to fluent speakers. This programme gives volunteers valuable, hands-on experience in international education, offering insight into classroom dynamics and childhood development in a rural Vietnamese context. Through both English lessons and sports activities, volunteers help build essential life skills, boost student confidence, and inspire a love for learning.

Our English development initiative supports schools in Sa Pa and Yen Bai, where students often lack regular exposure to spoken English. Volunteers assist with classroom lessons, helping improve confidence and conversational skills, and also run after-school English clubs to make learning more engaging. As part of the project, you'll also help revamp classrooms, creating more inspiring spaces for students to learn and thrive.

Project 2: Sports Development

The Sports Development Project promotes physical activity and teamwork through PE lessons and after-school sports clubs in schools. Volunteers support teachers, lead games, and encourage participation. You'll also help with renovating school playing fields, improving facilities to create safe and fun environments where students can stay active and build confidence.

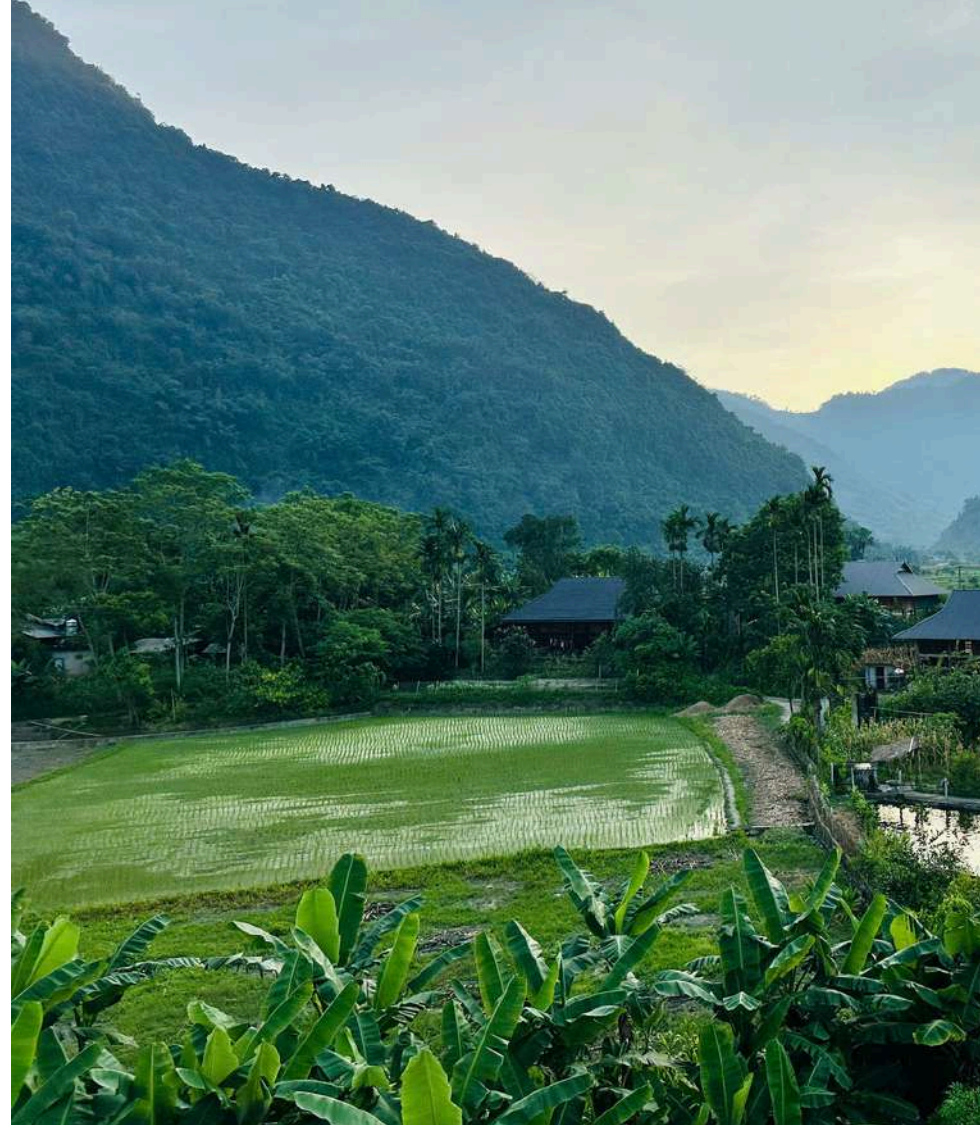


VIETNAM PROGRAMME ADD-ON:

Volunteer in Morocco.

Morocco is located in the northwest corner of Africa and is bordered by the Atlantic Ocean and Mediterranean on one edge and the Western Sahara on the other.

The country is home to a rich culture, historic ruins and a variety of landscapes from desert sand dunes through to dramatic mountain ranges!

The Moroccan people are Berber and Arab, and most of the population is Muslim. A large part of Morocco is mountainous, with the beautiful Atlas Mountains being located in the central and southern regions of the country. Many of the Berber people still live in the mountains and speak the Berber language.

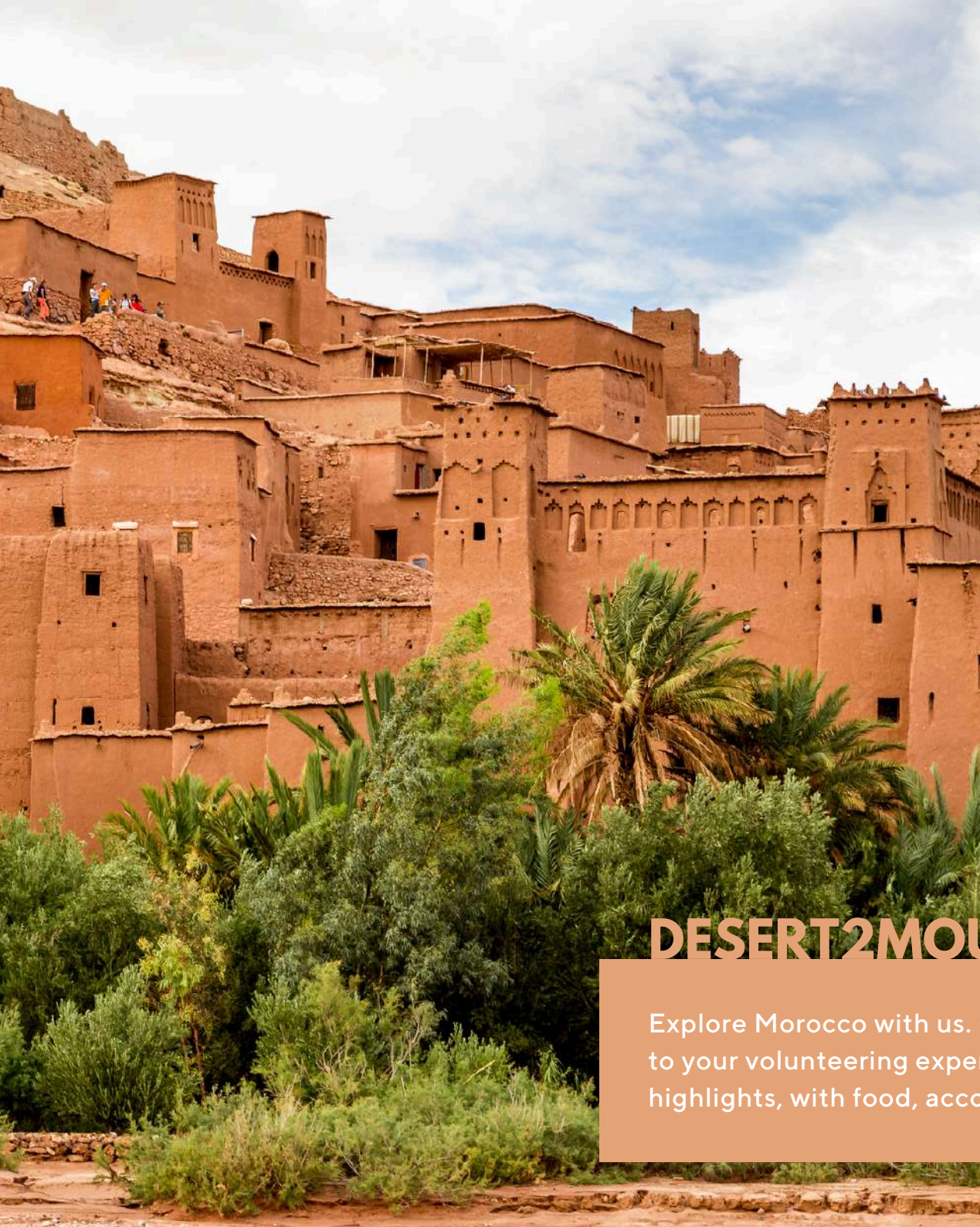

Project 1: Summer School

Volunteers will be running a Summer School throughout the summer months. This will be open to any local children who are looking to improve their English, play sports and get involved in fun educational activities.

How much should I raise?

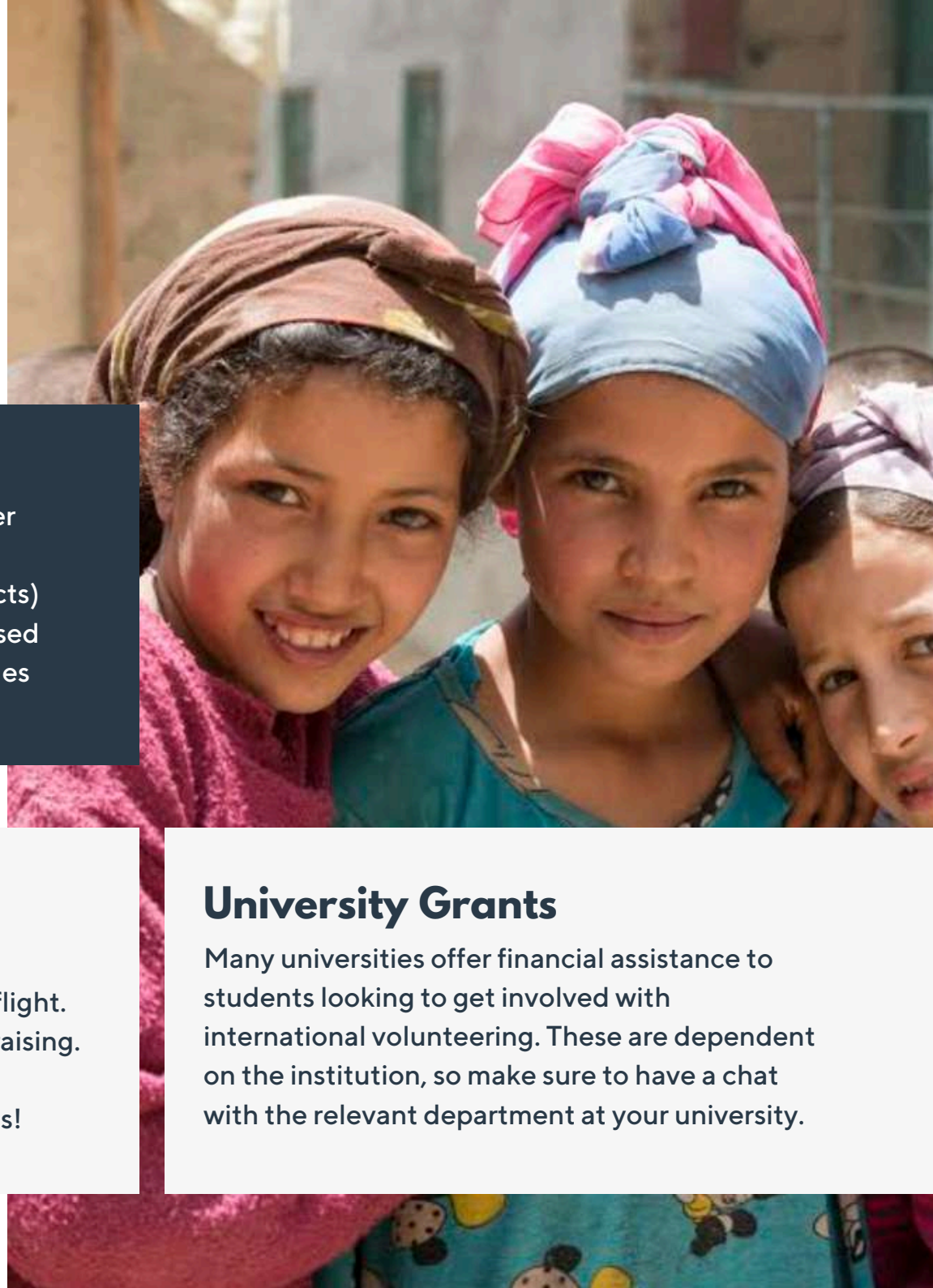
We require each volunteer to fundraise a minimum of £75 per week they volunteer with us. Volunteers who are doing a programme of 4 weeks or more (excluding Healthcare Projects) have a maximum required threshold of £300. The money raised enables us to buy equipment, further develop the programmes and improve quality of life in disadvantaged communities.

Flight Reimbursement

Volunteers are entitled to put any money over their required fundraising threshold towards the travel cost of their return flight. This will be reimbursed once you have completed your fundraising. Any surplus money exceeding the cost of your flight will be donated to Travelteer Impact to further our charitable causes!

University Grants

Many universities offer financial assistance to students looking to get involved with international volunteering. These are dependent on the institution, so make sure to have a chat with the relevant department at your university.

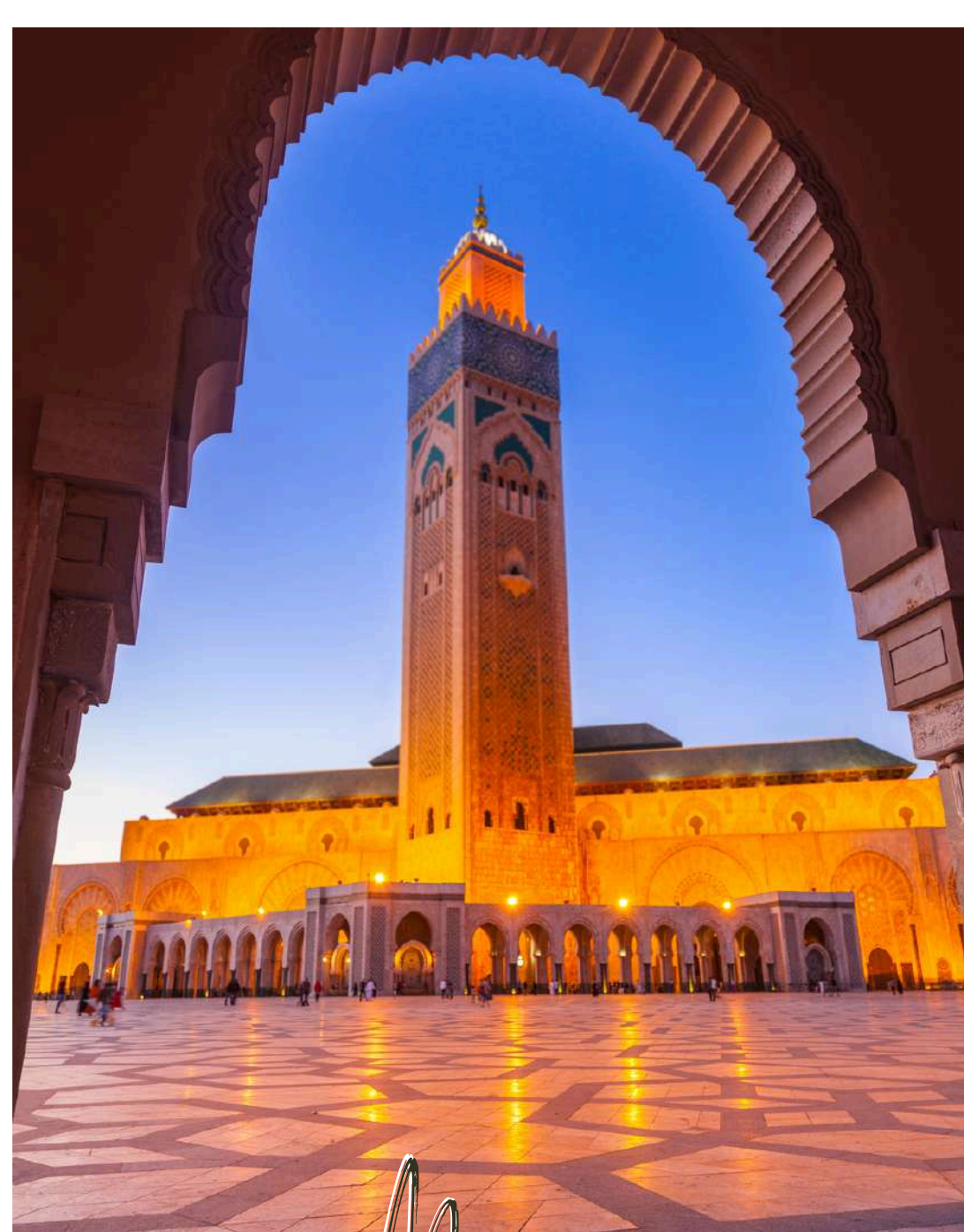
