Your teacher will send you the materials covered during the class which you have missed, and you will be able to use the answer key to go through the learning points which you have missed.

Please bear in mind that it is always much better for your learning to attend a lesson in person rather than to study the same materials independently, so try to avoid absences whenever possible.
