Source 1: Eight Guineas Reward

Eight Guineas REWARD.

WHEREAS on the Night of Saturday last, the 28th of October Instant, the **SHED** or **POULTRY HOUSE** belonging to Mr **ISAAC BOLTON**, situate behind Mr Walker's Ropery, was broke and entered, and two **Cocks**, five **Hens**, one **Mason's Hammer**, and a **Crow Bar** stolen therefrom: And last Week, the **Stones** of the **Foundations** of certain **Houses** in **Bedford Street** were broken, and **Part** thereof carried away.

A **Reward** of **Five Guineas** will be paid by the said **Isaac Bolton**; and a further **Reward** of **Three Guineas** by the **North Shields and Tynemouth Association for Prosecuting Felons**, on conviction of the **Offender**, to any **Person** who shall give such **Information** so as to lead to a **Conviction**.

The **Association** at **North Shields**, at a **General Meeting**, resolved to prosecute to the utmost rigour of the **Law** in future, the **Depredators** on the **Property** belonging to any of its **Members**: And all **Tradesmen** are hereby cautioned against buying **POULTRY**, &c. of suspicious **Persons**.

WHEREAS, on Thursday Night the 19th February Instant, some evil disposed Person, or Persons maliciously broke and destroyed a new Gate ; broke and materially damaged two Ploughs, and pulled down, and carried away a Quantity of Railing, the Property of Mr John Crawford, upon his Farm, situate in the Township of Monkseaton.

A Reward of **THREE GUINEAS** will be paid by Mr John Crawford ; and a further Reward of **TWO GUINEAS** by the North Shields and Tynemouth Association for Prosecuting Felons, to any Person, or Persons who shall give such Information as may lead to the Conviction of the Offender or Offenders.

LINEN STOLEN.

5 Guineas Reward.

WHEREAS on *Tuesday*, the 19th Day of May Instant, between the Hours of 4 and 5 o'Clock in the Afternoon, the following Wearing Apparel, and other Articles were stolen from off the Line where the same were hanging to dry, in a Garden behind Mr. W. RICHARDSON'S House, situate in Percy Street, near Walker Place, North Shields, viz. 1 striped Kerseymere purple and white Waistcoat with yellow Buttons; 1 buff Kerseymere ditto without Buttons; 2 flannel Petticoats; 1 Shift (*quite new*); 1 Dimity Night Gown; 1 Cotton Night Gown; 1 white Dimity Chair Cover with Fringe (*quite new*); 2 Girl's Dimity Petticoats; 1 Child's white Frock (tucked at the bottom); 3 Child's Shifts, No 1, 4, and 5, marked A. L. Madgin, with durable Ink; 3 Shifts; 3 Caps; 1 Sheet marked I. C. A.; 1 Blanket; 2 chequered Aprons, and 1 white Linen Apron.

A REWARD of 2 *Guineas* will be paid by the said W. RICHARDSON, and a further REWARD of 3 *Guineas* by the North Shields and Tynemouth Association for Prosecuting Felons, to any Person, or Persons, who shall give such Information as may lead to the Conviction of the Offender, or Offenders.

N. B. A Man and Woman of suspicious appearance were seen lurking about Northumberland Street, and Percy Street, a short time before the Theft was committed.

One Hundred GUINEAS *REWARD.*

WHEREAS

During the night of Wednesday last, or early on Thursday morning, several Persons assembled and endeavoured to force open the doors of the Houses occupied by the Horse-keepers of the Hetton Coal Company, by throwing *Stones, & using other violent means ; and also threatened to MURDER the Horse-keepers, in case they attended their employ as usual,*
