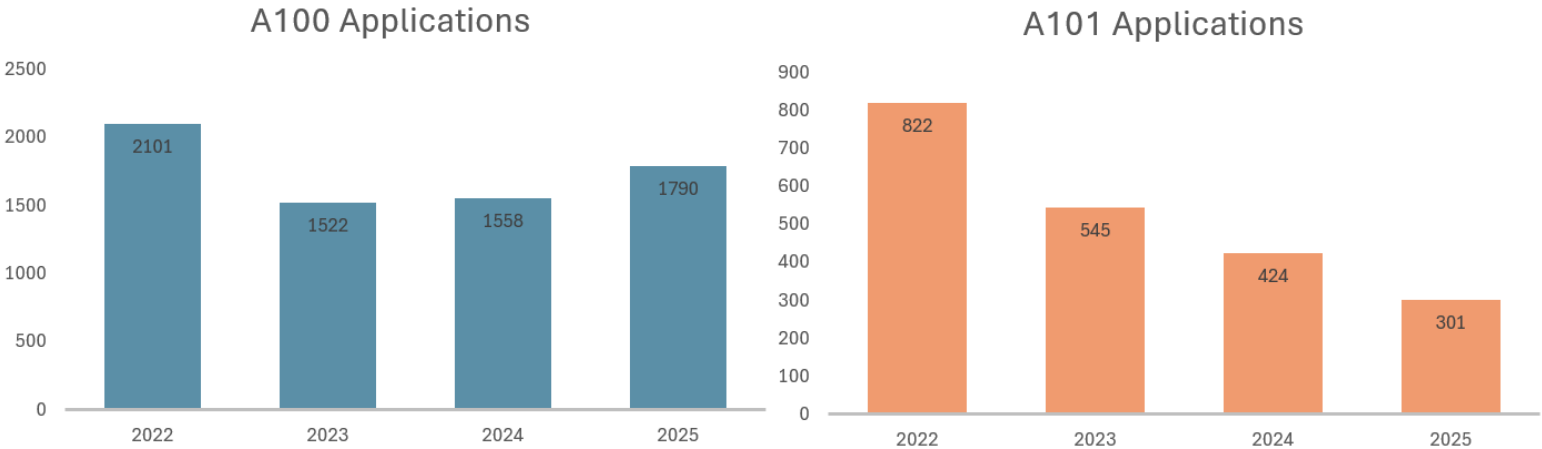

For 2026 Entry:

- Home students will be given an academic score based on their **most recent achieved** grades, expect for candidates applying with Access to HE or honours degrees. We will then award up to an additional 60 points based on your UCAT score. For more information, please visit [Apply to Medicine](#).
- Widening Participation and PARTNERS students will be assessed separately from Home Standard applicants in all parts of the selection process.
- For all international applicants and all A101 applicants, following the screen for achieved or predicted academic results, UCAT score will form the sole basis for ranking and selection for interview.
- UCAT ANZ for will be accepted for applicants applying to UK, partner consortium and Australian/New Zealand consortium universities.
