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Appendix A

UCAT Exempt

- All applicants should sit the UCAT exam. If you live in a country which does not have a test centre, we
 expect you to travel to your nearest test centre. If you believe that you cannot sit the test for medical
 reasons, we will require sufficient supporting evidence regarding those medical circumstances. This
 information should be sent to <u>mbbs.admissions@ncl.ac.uk</u> and we will consider the supporting
 evidence and provide potential applicants with a decision on whether we would consider their
 request to be exempt from sitting the UCAT.
- If you are given the decision that you are exempt from sitting the UCAT and you apply to us through UCAS, we will consider and score your academic achievement, predictions, personal statement and reference to identify whether you are to be offered an interview.
- All requests and supporting evidence for a UCAT Exemption to be considered must be received by 30 September. Being considered UCAT exempt by another university does not mean that we will allocate an exemption.
- EVIDENCE: If you are requesting to be made exempt on medical grounds, you will need to provide formal supporting evidence detailing any reasonable adjustments you may require which could not be replicated in a test centre. You will need to provide evidence from the test centre to say they were unable to make reasonable adjustments. If your request is due to illness during the test period we would need supporting evidence which sets out the details and timeline of the illness, limitations caused by illness, original confirmation of booked UCAT test and attempts to rebook a test; all absences from school/college or employment due to illness.
- Please note that the UCAT test can be taken over a period of several months. It is beneficial to the applicant to book and sit the UCAT at their earliest opportunity to prevent problems if a need arises to rebook the test.
- Our decision on whether the UCAT exemption is acceptable is final and there will be no form of appeal. Decisions made by other Universities on a potential applicant eligibility will not form any part of our decision.
- Failure to submit your request to <u>mbbs.admissions@ncl.ac.uk</u> by 30 September with all of the appropriate supporting evidence will not be considered.
