

2023 "Chinese Bridge" for UK Schools

- Exploring China Programme for Headteachers

Introduction

The 2023 "Chinese Bridge" Programme for headteachers aims at enhancing educational cooperation between China and UK and promoting Chinese language and culture. Participants will visit educational institutions and schools in China, and engage in in-depth exchanges with local educational institutes and learn about Chinese culture. The programme is organized by China Centre for Language Education and Cooperation and co-organized by the Xiamen University and the Confucius Institute at Newcastle University.

Programme details

> Length: 7-10 days

Funding: the ground expenses (e.g., accommodation, domestic transportation, and group activities) during the period of participation in China will be sponsored by China Centre for Language Education and Cooperation

> Criteria:

- The programme is open to headteachers, school principals or co-teachers of UK schools with Chinese language and cultural programmes.
- 2. Participants have not joined in this programme within the past three years.
- 3. Participants should be under 65 years of age, physically healthy enough for international travel.
