- To work as a team to help deliver the over-arching purpose of the Newcastle Rugby Foundation to the highest standard
- To contribute to the Newcastle Rugby Foundation's overarching purpose and impact measurements (Boost wellbeing, Grow Skills, Raise involvement, Build Belonging)

Key responsibilities as part of this role include:

- Deliver a variety of rugby sessions at the Newcastle Rugby Foundations half term coaching camps
- Deliver high quality rugby sessions to engage boys and girls of all ages. (6-16)
- Promote and deliver community coaching camps during school holidays across the region.
- Promote Newcastle Rugby within the community.

- Transition participants to a local rugby club
- Number of Newcastle Rugby Foundation coaching camps developed in the region
