RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL) AND CREDIT TRANSFER

SCOPE OF APPLICATIONS

In principle, Newcastle University Business School (NUBS) considers applications for RPL and credit transfer for all postgraduate programmes and makes this available for all modules to a maximum of 20 credits. Applicants should, however, note that their qualifications and experience will be judged on their individual merits and will take account of any accreditation requirements for specific programmes. In other words, each case will be considered on the following criteria:

- a) appropriate level of credit transfer
- b) accredited or equivalent recognition of certificated learning
- c) recognition of prior experiential learning (e.g. industry experience)

HOW RPL/CREDIT TRANSFER DECISIONS ARE MADE

Applications should be submitted via email to the relevant degree programme director above for consideration and will be considered jointly with the relevant admissions selector. Applicants should hear the results of their application within 20 working days. Due to AMBA requirements no more than 20 per cent of a student cohort may be admitted with RPL and credit transfer.
