


UNIVERSITY STAFF AND STUDENTS: THINGS TO CONSIDER



Don't expect or demand help for 'your' projects - be respectful, and aware of the volume of requests some organisations receive.

Address the potential benefits to the VCSE partner and communities. Ask what you can offer – time, an information session, some evaluation or literature review? Be honest about potential limitations too.

Direct funding to your Voluntary Sector partner, where possible. Don't undervalue their support, or assume they are 'free' or 'cheap' to work with.

Take ethics seriously, and take your partner's advice on how to minimise harm and safeguard the communities they serve.

Prepare students and Voluntary Sector partners carefully for placements, don't just 'throw them in'.

Make sure outputs and datasets can be accessed by all partners after the project. *Voluntary Sector partners should have the opportunity to comment on outputs, and co-author where appropriate.*
