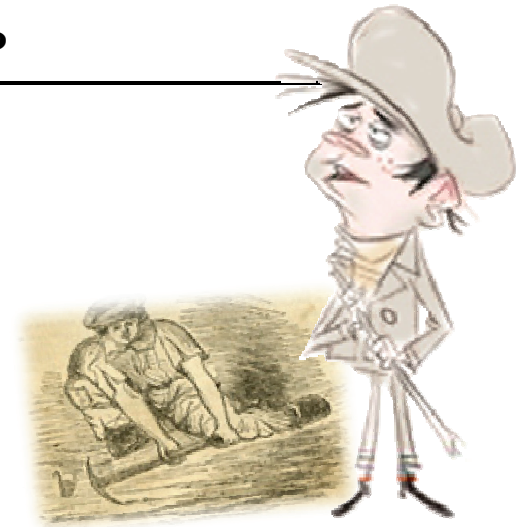


Mining - Children in the Mines – Should Johnny go to work in the mines?
